

THE TOWN OF PERALTA IS GIVING LEGAL NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FROM ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS FOR WASTEWATER PLANNING, DESIGN, AND CONSTRUCTION SERVICES PERTAINING TO THE TOWN'S WASTEWATER COLLECTION SYSTEM THAT IS CURRENTLY BEING SERVICED BY BOSQUE FARMS WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT. PROJECT NO. CWSRF-57. PROPOSALS DUE: TUESDAY, OCTOBER 10TH, 2017, AT 3:00PM.

The Town is seeking proposals from professional Engineering firms or persons to provide professional services for the above project. Proposals will be accepted until 3:00pm on the date shown above, at the Peralta Town Hall, located at 90A Molina Rd., Peralta, NM 87042. No proposals will be accepted after the time specified. Request for proposal packets may be picked up at the Peralta Town Office, or requested via phone, townofperalta.org website or via e-mail (see contact info below).

Project Description:

The proposed project will be for planning, design and construction management of Peralta's wastewater collection services to residents and businesses using sewer lines installed by Peralta, which are serviced by the Bosque Farms Wastewater treatment plant. The Town is seeking continuation the sewer project as it is outlined in the PER that was approved by NMED CPB on 3/26/2014. Professional services shall include the review and completion of the Environmental Information Document (EID) and address any potential environmental impacts of the project. Scope of work will be to continue with phased design of the system, assistance with construction bidding and contract negotiation, construction administration, oversight and project close out duties.

This project is wholly or partially funded with United States Environmental Protection Agency funds, and therefore must comply with all federal cross cutter requirements. Neither the United States nor its department's agencies or employees is or will be party to this invitation for bids or any resulting contract. This procurement will be subject to regulations contained in 40CFR part 31.

All qualified applicants will receive consideration for employment without regard to race, color, religion, sex or national origin. Bidders on this work will be required to comply with the President's Executive Order No. 11246, as amended.

The Offeror must make a good faith effort to solicit and hire Disadvantaged Business subcontractors and suppliers to meet the goals outlined in EPA XP-215. A good faith effort requires that the Offeror: 1) Complete the affirmative steps outlined in XP-215, 2) Submit XP-215 with the proposal, 3) Submit with the proposal proof that affirmative steps have been taken and this should include copies of advertisements and letters of solicitation. A Proposal that omits XP-215 or does not support that a good faith effort was made will be considered non-responsive and the Proposal rejected.
